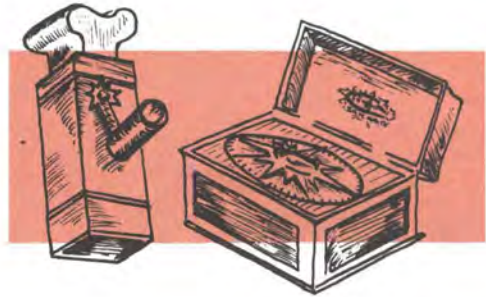

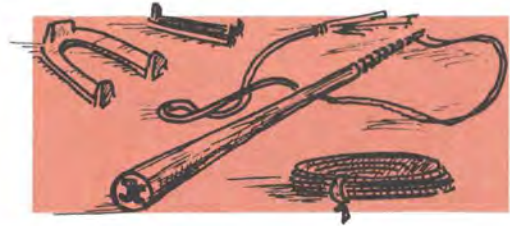

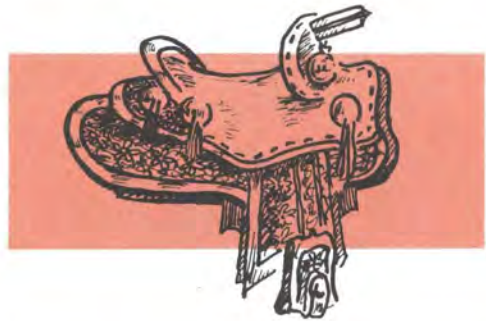

All trains to the West were governed by the wagon-master or captain, who, as commander of the caravan, was in sole possession of the compass which provided the necessary directions for the hazardous journey. Often nicknamed "Wagon Jack", he, as "King of the road," selected camp sites, assigned trail scouts and guards for night duty, and made certain that the work of the train was done each day.

The stock was always watered, fed, and guarded at night, and guards were under the direct guidance of the wagon-master.

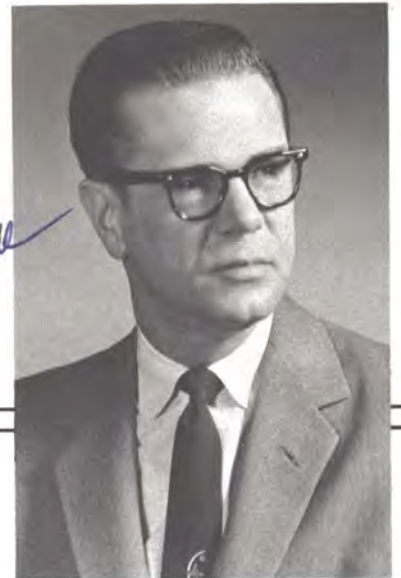

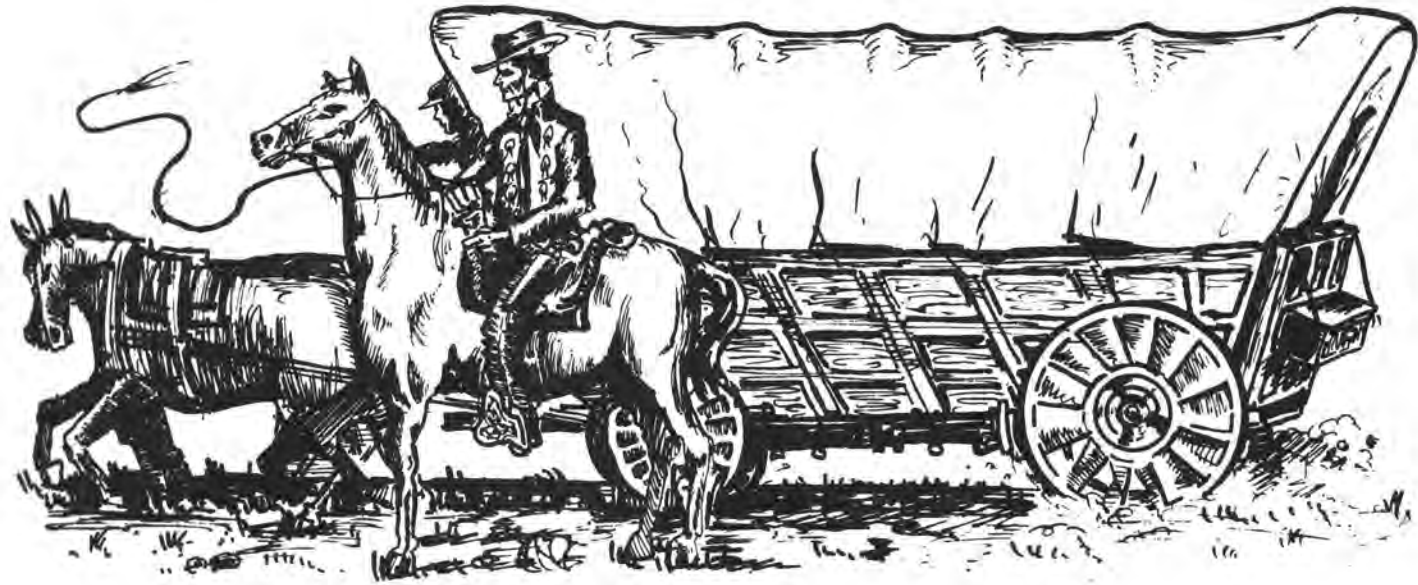

This constant travel, in spite of hunger and fatigue, in spite of broken wagons and lame animals, was performed by the muleteers or drivers, who, with bullwhips in hand, yelled "Mule ho! Mule-ah!", as the long train moved inexorably across the grassy plain.

Likewise, our seniors—those traveling teamsters—have successfully forded the rivers of reason and avoided the quicksands of Quakerland in "whipping" all obstacles to the completion of their memorable journey over the treacherous terrain of Franklin's frontier.

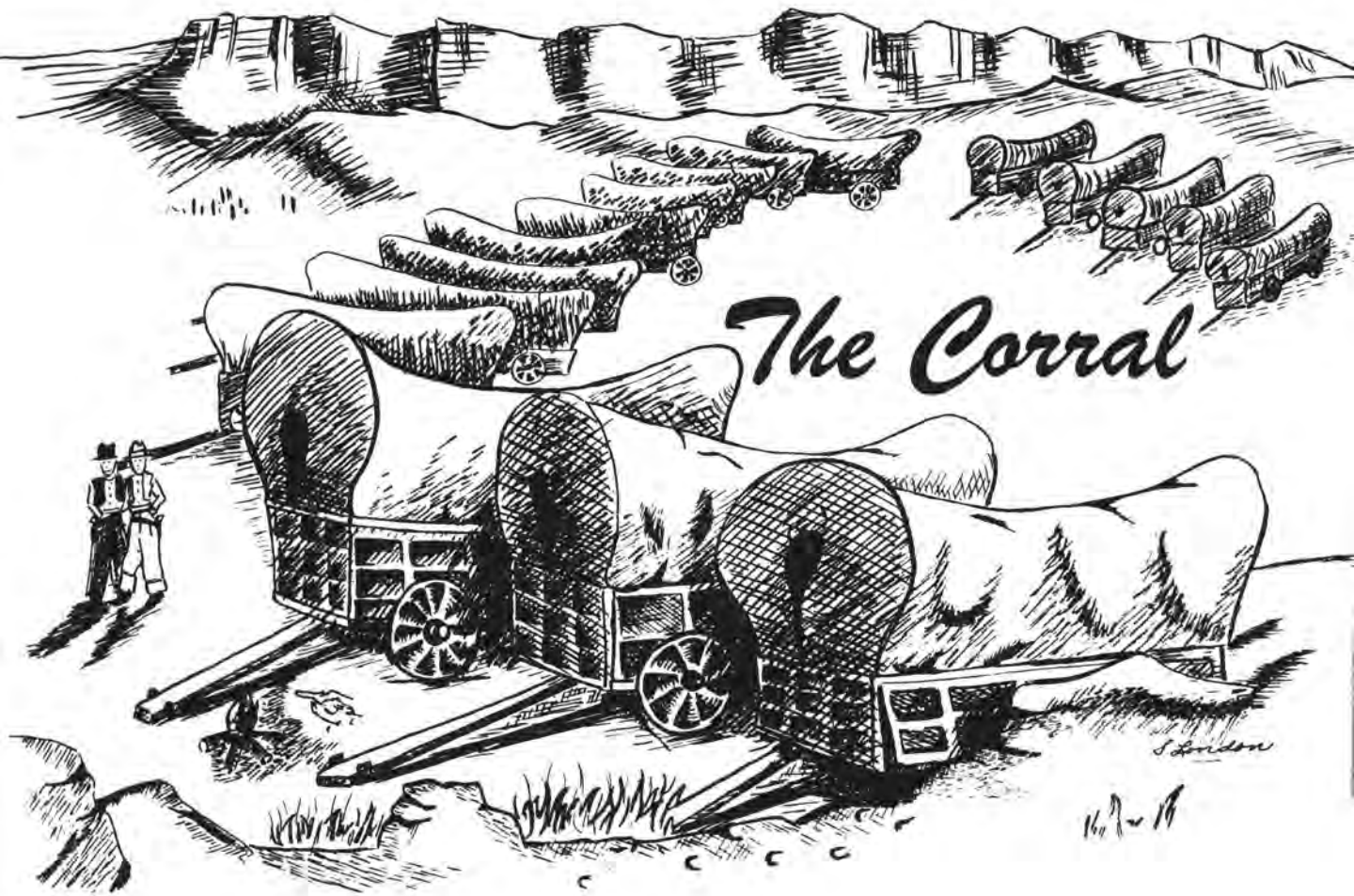
- To Mr. Sabin we leave our heartfelt appreciation for the guidance which he has given us during these most important years of our life.
